HR 676	No Same as	Conyers (D-MI) 48 cosponsors	Expanded and Improved Medicare for All	To provide for comprehensive health insurance coverage for all United States residents, improved health care delivery, and for other purposes.
SJ Res 15	Cardin (D-MD) 27 cosponsor	No Same as	ERA 3 State	Removes the ratification deadline from the stalled Equal Rights Amendment allowing 3 more states to ratify the ERA. State legislation to ratify the ERA has been introduced in Virginia and Nevada. Legislation is still active in Florida and North Carolina

HR 1460	No Same as	Cartwright (D-PA) 63 cosponsors	Focused Reduction of Effluence and Stormwater runoff through Hydrofracking Environmental Regulation Act of 2015	To amend the Federal Water Pollution Control Act and direct the Secretary of the Interior to conduct a study with respect to stormwater runoff from oil and gas operations, and for other purposes.
HR 1902	No Same as	Pocan (D-WI) 12 cosponsors	Protect our Public Lands Act	To ban hydraulic fracturing on land owned by the United States and leased to a third party, and for other purposes.
HR 1482/S785	Related Casey (D-PA)	DeGette (D-CO) 26 cosponsors	Fracturing Responsibility and Awareness of Chemicals Act	To repeal the exemption for hydraulic fracturing in the Safe Drinking Water Act, and for other purposes.
