President Obama has announced that he plans to sign the TPP on February 4th; Congress will vote in the coming months on whether or not to approve the deal.

SOTU and ITC

- 1) The ITC held 3 days of hearings in preparation for its required report on the expected economic impacts of the TPP. Labor and family farmers testified that it needs to adequately account for currency manipulation and other areas it usually neglects.
- 2) The President devoted a mere 28 seconds to discussing the TPP, perhaps reflecting the bipartisan lack of appetite in Congress to take a tough vote before the election. Do not mistake this for any break in the heavy lobbying for it by the administration and business.

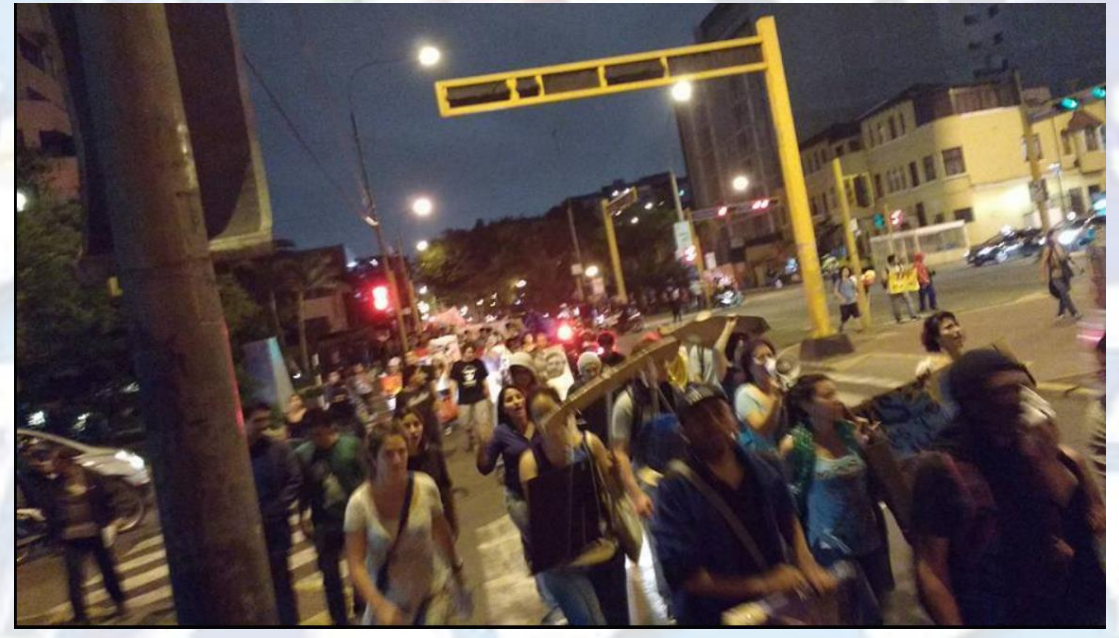

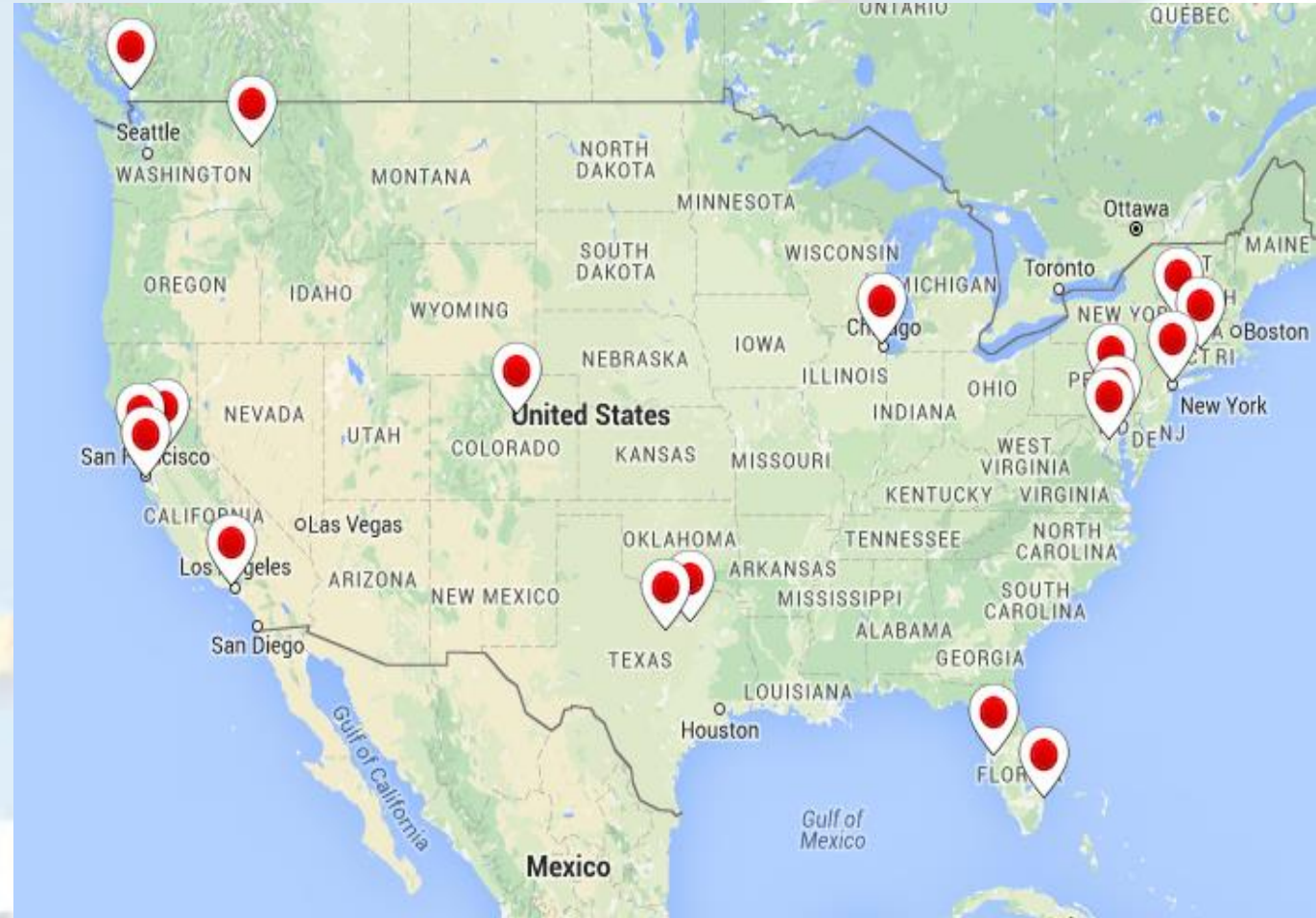

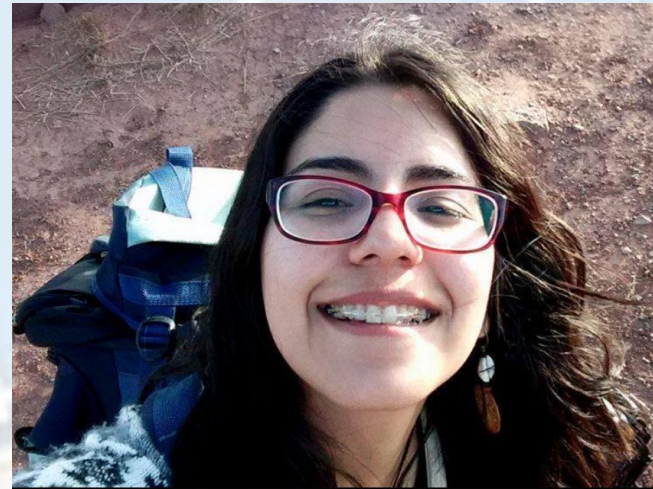
