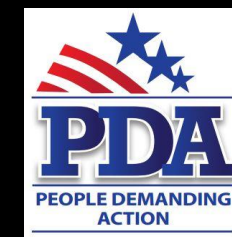

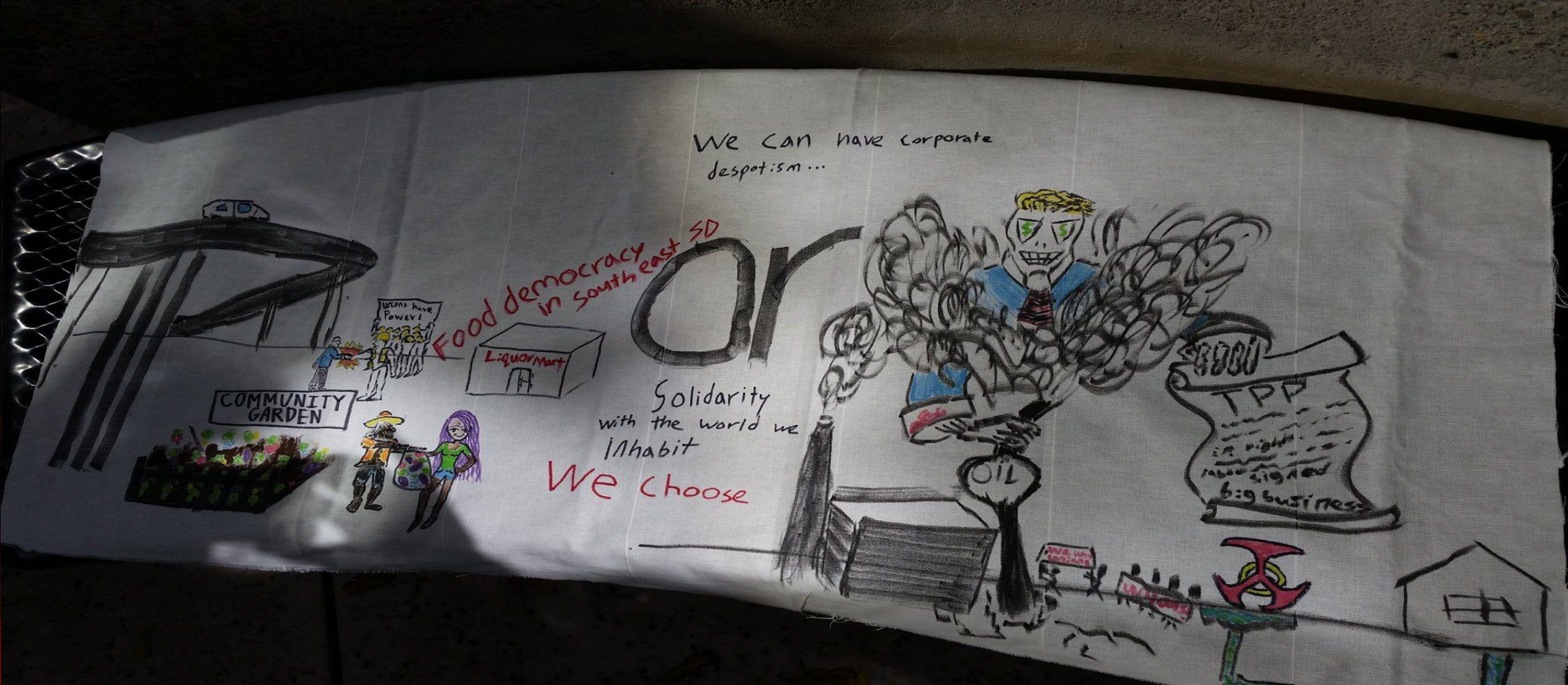

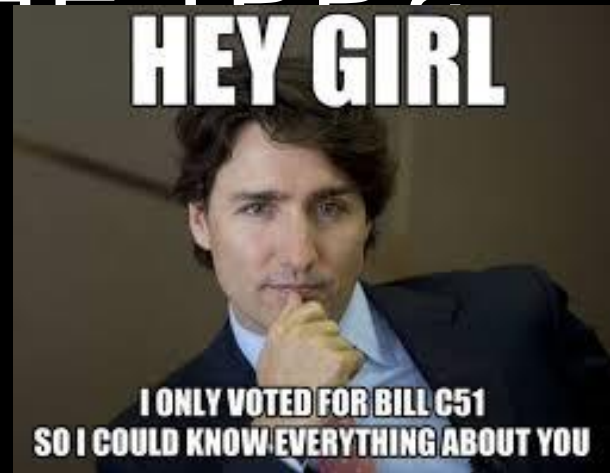

# SINCE THEN?

- Some wins, normally, MAI, and FTAA, but Canada has normalized free trade as 'good for the economy''
- Explosion in bilateral agreements
- Liberals and NDP used to be staunch opponents to the free trade, now the Liberals support
- Conservative government ideologically pro-free trade at any cost, negotiating at any cost
- Negotiated supply management and auto during TPP despite having caretaker government

# POLITICAL LANDSCAPE OF CANADA: LIBERALS 184 OF THE 338 SEATS

- Liberal Majority government with Justin Trudeau
- Minority versus majority system, party discipline
- Brokerage party history: promises a 'non-ideological' government
- Chyrstia Freeland, economic journalist, former Trade Minister probably going to Finance or Foreign Affairs criticizes lack of speed
- Trade Lawyers Catherine Mckenna, Melanie Joly, Rachel Bendahen, many donors from business
- Criticizes also trade deficits excacerbated under Harper
- Criticizes secrecy and Harper approach
- In the Munk debate Trudeau said, that Trade was important for jobs
- On October 5, the day the deal was announced, Liberal leader Justin Trudeau stated, "The Liberal Party of Canada strongly supports free trade... The government has an obligation to be open and honest about the negotiation process, and immediately share all the details of any agreement. Canadians deserve to know what impacts this agreement will have on different industries across our country. The federal government must keep its word and defend Canadian interests during the TPP's ratification process – which includes defending supply management, our auto sector, and Canadian manufacturers across the country. If the Liberal Party of Canada earns the honour of forming a government after October 19th, **we will hold a full and open public debate in Parliament to ensure Canadians are consulted on this historic trade agreement**"

# THE CONSERVATIVES: 99 SEATS

- Official opposition without leader
- Ideologically pro Free trade.
- Conservative Party and the takeover by the Reform Party
- Munk debate, 'In fact, Mr. Trudeau, 99 per cent of the free trade access in this country has been created by Conservative governments. What we always get from the Liberal party is platitudes on trade, but you don't have the vision, and you don't have the determination to actually sit at the table, make the tough decisions and get the deal. That's what we are doing:

# NDP ON TPP

- Traditionally the party of unions and civil society
- In last few years, NDP has tried to be a ruling party instead of a third place finisher, first time official opposition, 1st in the polls
- Did not want to be attacked by the press as being-pro trade
- Last weeks of the campaign, to shore up their base, started coming out against TPP
- Unifor and Agricultural votes important to NDP base
- Third place finish, have a moral role to play, one Green Party MP, Elizabeth May

# THREATS AND OPPORTUNITIES

- Canada was unaware of TPP, despite TPP meeting in Ottawa
- Needle moved a bit after Fast Track
- Needle moved considerably after opposition from auto workers, auto industry (Ford), and farmers, and last week of the election
- This government is pro-TPP, Obama, but
- Government is very international oriented, and more sensitive to pressure
- Council and allies calling for three things: 1) public consultations (civil society, labour, 1st nations, provinces)
- Proper analysis of text
- Reject ISDS, carveout in Paris
- Meetings with MPs Nov 7th.

- Doesn't make any of the "good language" binding.
- Extends the worst parts of US copyright to other countries.
- Does not mandate fair use provisions.
- Adopts harsh penalties that endanger whistleblowers.
- Pushes out the US' broken DMCA take down requirements.
- Let's be frank: it basically breaks the Internet.
